Florida Novel H1N1 Influenza Vaccine Waste Reason Codes:

1. Expired: Vaccine is past expiration date
2. Wasted: Dropped vial/Broken vial
3. Wasted: Drawn-up but not administered
4. Spoiled: Proper refrigeration/freezer temperature not maintained
5. Spoiled: Vaccine not refrigerated and/or stored improperly upon receipt
6. Spoiled: Refrigeration/mechanical failure
7. Unusable: Natural disaster/Power outage
8. Unusable: Lost or damaged in transit to provider
9. Recall: Vaccine returned to manufacturer or manufacturer's designee

Incident Report and Remedial Actions Taken: Provide a detailed explanation as to why the vaccine became unserviceable and the remedial actions taken to prevent a recurrence (*attach additional sheets of information, if necessary*).

- **Do not return novel H1N1 influenza vaccine that expires or becomes unserviceable to McKesson Specialty.** Providers must dispose of vaccine according to usual medical biosafety procedures.
