For your review and information, the attached results of the Bureau of Immunization assessments have been ranked according to performance by county. Individual analyses on these assessments have previously been sent to you. The high-risk infants data is cumulative data of reports on infants born October 1999 through September 2000 sent during fiscal year 2000-2001. The survey of two-year-old children reflects immunization levels statewide and by 12 selected counties: Broward, Dade, Duval, Escambia, Hillsborough, Lee, Leon, Orange, Palm Beach, Pinellas, Polk, and Volusia.

Please note the line drawn through each ranking on the attached sheets. Those counties above the line have reached the state goal for that assessment, and those listed below the line have not yet reached the established goal. We hope you will find this a convenient and useful tool in evaluating your immunization activities.
